4 Crime

a) Beat Officer's Report

PCSO Lora Bray reported the following for the period between 02/11/09 – 25/01/10: 2 thefts, 5 criminal damage, 1 non-dwelling burglary, 1 vehicle tampering and 4 logged calls of Anti-Social Behaviour.

There were several calls about 2 people calling at houses on behalf of Somerset and Dorset Air Ambulance selling their lottery and therefore asking for bank details. They were genuine.

Lora is looking for volunteers to help with a youth club for the village.

Cold Calling Zones: Lora is awaiting the template for the opt out letter which will be sent to all street members in areas requesting a cold calling zone. Funding might be difficult to find to set up a number of zones all at the same time.

b) Summary of recent WatchOut messages.

There had been a total of 12 messages since the last meeting. Messages are now sent out in .pdf format with the Woolavington Neighbourhood Watch logo attached.

c) Co-ordinators' Reports

There was one report of badger digging along the Huntspill River. June Irvine commented that in 2008 she had emailed PC Pete Wills, a PC at Burnham with responsibilities for wildlife crime, offering to put details of wildlife crime and prevention through our eWatch system but had not had a reply from the Bridgwater PC. She offered to email again.
